**Apology and Notice Regarding the Accident at the Company's Construction Site**  
**(Second Report)**

On April 7, 2026, an accident occurred at a facility demolition construction site being executed by the Company (JFE Steel Corporation East Japan Works (Keihin District), Kawasaki City, Kanagawa Prefecture), in which six workers were involved (hereinafter referred to as the "Accident"). As a result of the Accident, three persons have passed away, two persons were injured, and one person remains missing. We pray for the repose of the souls of those who have passed away and offer our heartfelt condolences to their bereaved families, and we also extend our sincere sympathies to those who were injured.

We also deeply apologize for the significant inconvenience and concern caused to all parties concerned.

We hereby announce the current status of our response to the Accident as described below.

**1. Search for the Missing Person**

At present, one worker still remains missing. In order to rescue this person as soon as possible, we are devoting our full efforts to the search activities with the cooperation of the relevant authorities.

**2. Establishment of the Recurrence Prevention Committee**

Immediately after the accident, the Company worked to identify the cause and implemented urgent recurrence prevention measures, including further strengthening the safety measures it had taken to date.

Today, the Company's Board of Directors resolved to establish a "Recurrence Prevention Committee," led primarily by the outside directors, in order to re-examine from multiple perspectives the factors that undermine safety and to further strengthen its safety measures.

Please note that, as the investigation by the relevant authorities into the detailed cause and circumstances of the Accident is still ongoing, the Company refrains from expressing its own views at the present time.

### **3. Impact on Business Results**

At the present time, no impact on business results, such as the suspension of construction work or a decrease in newly acquired construction projects, has occurred. Inquiries for construction projects are also progressing in line with our outlook. The recruitment of construction supervisors, which has a medium- to long-term impact, is likewise progressing in line with our outlook. As it is currently impossible to calculate the direct impact of the Accident on profit and loss, the impact on business results remains undetermined; should a significant impact on business results be expected in the future, we will promptly report it in accordance with the timely disclosure rules.

In addition, with respect to the impact on the Medium-Term Management Plan, of which the current fiscal year is the first year, there are no matters to be reported, such as revisions, at the present time. Should any matters requiring disclosure arise, we will report them promptly.

Safety takes precedence over all else. Positioning this principle once again at the very top of our management priorities, all officers and employees will work together as one to rebuild our culture of safety. We will continue to make unceasing efforts to restore the trust of all our stakeholders.
