Hamee Corp. (Head Office: Odawara City, Kanagawa Prefecture, President and CEO:Ikuhiro Mizushima, Securities Code 3134: TSE Standard Market) announces ParallelPlastics, a plastic up-cycle service, will begin a collaboration with Takashimaya Co., Ltd.'s "Depart de Loop Cosmetics Recycling Project" and the John Masters Organics Group.

As a first step, we've jointly developed an "upcycled comb" made from 100% recycled plastic, using empty cosmetic containers collected from Takashimaya customers and John Masters Organics.

It will be released for limited quantity on Wednesday, October 1, 2025, at some stores and EC, including John Masters Organics in Takashimaya.



■ Background of ParallelPlastics's collaboration with Takashimaya's "Depart de Loop Cosmetics Recycling Project"

"ParallelPlastics" has transformed a wide range of unwanted plastic products, mainly discontinued smartphone cases, into new, "usable products."

On the other hand, the Takashimaya's "Depart de Loop Cosmetics Recycling Project" has transformed unnecessary "makeup products" and "empty cosmetic containers" made of plastic materials into crayons and candles.

With the 2024 meeting at an eco-related exhibition, we began working toward collaboration. Approximately one year has passed since we launched the "upcycled comb" with 100% recycled plastics, including product design that draws out the attractiveness of materials, and design with an eye to safety, hygiene, and regeneration.

John Masters Organics was invited to this project for two main reasons. Firstly, we have been empathizing with the brand's philosophy of "making people and the earth beautiful." Secondly, as a leading hair care brand, we see a strong affinity between them and the customers of Takashimaya. The brand's commitment to both sustainability and high quality aligned perfectly with ParallelPlastics' upcycling technology and Takashimaya's vision for a circular production model. This synergy of the three parties' strengths led to the realization of this collaboration.

■ Jointly developed Corm with 100% recycled plastic to make used cosmetic containers a valuable product!


Collect empty cosmetics containers, and Takashimaya buyers sort and wash their own colors and types. Containers were subsequently upgraded by "ParallelPlastics" recycling process (milling and molding).

In the case of composite plastics, where more than two types of plastics are used, the effect is to create a marble pattern because of the different melting temperature of each.

In addition, about 10% of the "colors" derived from empty cosmetic containers are mixed, and the remaining 90% use recycled materials for housing parts that were scheduled to be discontinued and discarded.

This comb is also recommended for in-bus use, for example, by making hair treatments conform to our hair.

We offer a total of four types of color.

■ About the"Depart de Loop Cosmetics Recycling Project"




