Launch of “MightyChecker® Cloud X”, a New Cloud-Based Medical Claims Checking Software Product (Next-Generation Model)

—Featuring a “Management Analysis Function” to Visualize Medical Claims Data and Support Management Improvement at Medical Institutions—

Our group company, AIS Co., Ltd., hereby announces that it will launch “MightyChecker® Cloud X”, a new cloud-based medical claims checking software product (next-generation model) for clinics and small hospitals (with fewer than 100 beds), on April 1, 2026.

This product has been newly developed as an evolved model of “MightyChecker® Cloud” which has been offered to clinics. Leveraging many years of experience in the medical claims checking field and a robust medical data platform, it is a cloud service that combines a management analysis function designed to contribute to improving the profitability of medical institutions with guideline-compliant security that ensures a high level of safety.

1. Background to the Development and Future Outlook

As medical DX is being promoted as a national policy, the introduction of cloud-based systems at medical institutions is accelerating. At the same time, the management environment for medical institutions is becoming increasingly severe due to such factors as revisions to medical service fees, rising personnel expenses, and higher utility and medical material costs. Currently, approximately 70% of hospitals in Japan are operating at a deficit, and in addition to conventional operational efficiency improvements, there is a strong need for improved profitability through accurate management decision-making based on data. Furthermore, countermeasures against the increasing number of cyberattacks, as well as the establishment of advanced security frameworks compliant with the latest guidelines of the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare, have become urgent issues.

Against this backdrop, the Company believes that demand will continue to grow for highly functional cloud-based products capable of simultaneously addressing the two challenges faced by

medical institutions, namely “improving profitability” and “strengthening security”. For the Group, which boasts a top share in the industry, this represents an excellent opportunity to further enhance the value it provides to medical institutions and to develop new markets.

2. Key Features of MightyChecker® Cloud X

■ Improved Operational Efficiency Through a Renewed UI/UX

Operability has been significantly improved to optimize the entire workflow from medical claims checking to review and correction. This enables higher productivity in medical administration operations and reduces the burden on personnel.

■ Standard Equipped with a “Management Analysis Function” that Visualizes Medical Claims Data

Based on medical claims data accumulated on a daily basis, the system automatically analyzes and visualizes on a dashboard such indicators as trends in patient volume and unit prices, the ratio of first visits to repeat visits, and profitability by treatment category. This enables clinic directors and management teams to make prompt, data-driven and objective management decisions, rather than relying on experience or intuition, such as considering measures to improve repeat visit rates. As a result, the product contributes to improved profitability and enhanced quality of medical services.

■ Expansion of the Target Market (Support for Small Hospitals)

In addition to the conventional clinic segment, the product also supports small hospitals with fewer than 100 beds. This will enable expanded adoption in the small medical institution market, which accounts for approximately 40% of all hospitals in Japan.

■ Advanced Guideline-Compliant Security

Based on the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare’s “Guidelines for the Safety Management of Medical Information Systems, Edition 6.0” security measures, including network security, have been strengthened. Multi-factor authentication (two or more authentication factors), which is in principle required for access to medical information systems, is implemented as a standard feature. As a cloud service that handles medical information, the product delivers a high level of safety and compliance.

3. Future Outlook

Going forward, supported by improvements in the quality and quantity of the medical database that will become available through the deployment of this service, we will further enhance checking accuracy and strengthen its management support functions.

In addition, by capturing the national trend toward the cloud-based transformation of medical systems, we will accelerate expansion in the clinic segment, where the current adoption rate remains at approximately 18%, while also seeking to increase its share in the small hospital market.

4. About Ubicom Holdings, Inc.

The Company is a unique business innovation company committed to anticipating the needs of the times and creating IT solutions that help address social issues. Guided by this corporate philosophy, the Company operates two high-growth businesses, the Medical Business and the Technology Consulting Business.

In the Medical Business, the Company is a pioneer in management support IT solutions for hospitals and clinics utilizing an AI-powered subscription model. The Company’s offerings include “MightyChecker® EX,” a receipt inspection system that supports physicians’ workstyle reform, and “Mighty QUBE® Hybrid,” an electronic medical record integration system. Leveraging a robust customer base of more than 22,000 medical institutions built over more than 30 years, as well as medical databases and intellectual property, the Company is expanding new platform businesses. The Company has also launched the “Insurance Knowledge Platform” for

life and non-life insurance companies. Furthermore, from 2025 through 2030, the Company will promote an M&A strategy aimed at maximizing the profitability of the Medical Business. Through this strategy, the Company aims to complete a cumulative total of 8 to 10 M&A, each with annual sales ranging from several hundred million yen to approximately 1 billion yen, and to shift to a direct sales model led by the Group.

In the Technology Consulting Business, the Company operates under a global development framework centered in the Philippines and recruits and develops IT professionals fluent in both English and Japanese. The Company provides IT solutions across a wide range of industries, including healthcare, finance, and the public sector. In addition, the Company is promoting a shift from the traditional man-hour-based development model to an AI-driven development model. As part of its medium- to long-term strategy, the Company is driving a business model transformation toward a high-value-added, high-margin structure by developing AI talent, including prompt engineers, at its operations in the Philippines, enhancing AI utilization capabilities, and promoting the use of AI throughout the development process. Under its Go Global policy, the Company will continue to expand business opportunities with global companies by leveraging its advanced AI-enabled development capabilities.
