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1. Summary of business results

(1) Summary of business results during the period under review

During the third quarter of this consolidated fiscal year under review (April 1, 2025 to December 31, 2025), the Japanese economy exhibited a moderate recovery trend, supported by improvements in the employment and income environment and the expansion of inbound demand. On the other hand, the outlook remains uncertain due to rising resource and raw material prices, the impact of US trade policies, geopolitical risks such as the situations in Ukraine and the Middle East, and fluctuations in financial and capital markets. In such an economic environment, in the used car market, which is the primary target of the Company, the number of used car registrations in Japan from April 2025 through December 2025 (total of ordinary passenger vehicles, compact passenger vehicles, and mini four-wheeled passenger vehicles) was 3,955,871 units (up 0.2% year-on-year), exceeding the previous year's level. Based on the assumption of thoroughgoing compliance tailored to changes in the external business environment, including regulatory changes, our Group seeks to realize our mission: "We contribute to building a richer society by providing the best finance and services to people around the world" and "We will develop and nurture enriched human capital who consistently approach their work with a positive mindset and diligently build upon every process." To expand business interactions and accelerate growth in the scope of operations and earnings, we provide a comprehensive line of auto mobility services that assist automobile dealers and automobile maintenance facilities, our major client base, in various vehicle-related processes, in addition to credit and automobile warranty services. We are also tackling the challenge of implementing various initiatives to realize a new growth model.

Summarized below is the status of each business during the third quarter of this consolidated fiscal year under review. The results shown exclude operating revenues from internal sales between segments.

In the Finance Business, growth in the volume of new loans slowed temporarily as the impact of the temporary suspension of new applications due to the rollback to the old system, the prioritization of debt collection operations, and the interest rate rise implemented in the second quarter continued into the third quarter. On the other hand, efforts to retain customers by encouraging them to join the Car Premium Club and improvements in the support system through the addition of back-office personnel proved effective. As a result, the volume of new loans slightly exceeded the previous year's level, with operating revenue of 17,733 million yen (up 14.7% year-on-year) and operating profit of 3,164 million yen (down 27.0% year-on-year).

In the Automobile Warranty Business, energetic efforts to attract customers to the Car Premium Club and revised product offerings for OEM partners proved successful. As a result, automobile warranty transaction volume continued to exceed the previous year's level, with operating revenue of 5,904 million yen (up 14.2% year-on-year). Furthermore, operating profit reached 978 million yen (up 27.4% year-on-year) due to continuous cost reduction measures, such as the expansion of higher-margin proprietary warranty products.

In the Auto Mobility Services Business, steady progress in the Car Premium Club and subscription-based sale (leasing), combined with the containment of operating expenses, resulted in operating revenue of 7,577 million yen (up 11.7% year-on-year) and operating profit of 1,387 million yen (up 49.5% year-on-year).

Operating expenses were 25,705 million yen (up 20.0% year-on-year). While cost reduction measures such as cost savings in the Automobile Warranty Business continued to be effective, expenses associated with system-related and other costs increased.

As a result of the above, during the cumulative period through the third quarter of this consolidated fiscal year under review, operating revenue was 31,366 million yen (up 14.4% year-on-year), operating profit was 5,662 million yen (down 5.8% year-on-year), profit before tax was 5,897 million yen (down 2.5% year-on-year), and profit attributable to owners of parent was 4,061 million yen (down 1.2% year-on-year).

(2) Summary of financial position during the period under review

1) Status of assets, liabilities and equity

(Assets)

At the end of the third quarter of this consolidated fiscal year under review, total assets stood at 191,022 million yen, an increase of 6,034 million yen from the end of the previous consolidated fiscal year. This was mainly due to increases of 11,845 million yen in cash and cash equivalents and 6,038 million yen in financing receivables, which were partially offset by decreases of 7,775 million yen in other assets and 5,808 million yen in Insurance assets.

(Liabilities)

At the end of the third quarter of this consolidated fiscal year under review, total liabilities stood at 167,494 million yen, up 1,455 million yen from the end of the previous consolidated fiscal year. This was due mainly to an increase of 29,457 million yen in borrowings, as well as declines of 23,086 million yen in financial guarantee contracts and 4,961 million yen in other financial liabilities.

(Equity)

At the end of the third quarter of this consolidated fiscal year under review, total equity stood at 23,528 million yen, up 4,579 million yen from the end of the previous consolidated fiscal year. This was due mainly to an increase of 2,246 million yen in retained earnings. Total equity attributable to owners of parent grew 4,582 million yen from the end of the previous consolidated fiscal year to 23,505 million yen.

2) Status of cash flows

A look at cash flow during the cumulative period through the third quarter of this consolidated fiscal year under review shows expenditures of 16,181 million yen from operating activities (vs. expenditures of 1,308 million yen in the same period of the previous consolidated fiscal year); expenditures of 803 million yen from investing activities (vs. expenditures of 1,495 million yen in the same period of the previous consolidated fiscal year); and revenue of 28,808 million yen from financing activities (vs. expenditures of 212 million yen in the same period of the previous consolidated fiscal year). As a result, cash and cash equivalents (hereinafter "funds") at the end of the third quarter of the current consolidated fiscal year stood at 28,991 million yen.

The status of each cash flow and contributing factors during the cumulative period through the third quarter of the fiscal year under review are as follows.

(Cash flow from operating activities)

Funds diverted to sales activities during the cumulative period through the third quarter of the consolidated fiscal year under review totaled 16,181 million yen. Major revenues included a decline of 13,660 million yen in other assets and profit before tax for the period of 5,897 million yen. Major expenses included a decline of 23,086 million yen in financial guarantee contracts, an increase of 6,038 million yen in financing receivables, and a decline of 4,402 million yen in other financial liabilities.

(Cash flow from investing activities)

Funds diverted to investments during the cumulative period through the third quarter of the consolidated fiscal year under review totaled 803 million yen. Major revenues from investing activities included proceeds of 345 million yen from the sale of property, plant and equipment; major expenditures included 537 million yen for the purchase of property, plant and equipment, 397 million yen for the purchase of intangible assets, and 160 million yen for payments for guarantee deposits.

(Cash flow from financing activities)

Funds diverted to financing activities during the cumulative period through the third quarter of the consolidated fiscal year under review totaled 28,808 million yen. Major revenues from financing activities included proceeds from long-term borrowings of 43,494 million yen and proceeds from the disposal of treasury shares of 1,764 million yen; major expenditures included 13,565 million yen in repayment of long-term borrowings and 2,000 million yen in repayment of short-term borrowings.

(3) Explanation of forward-looking information, including consolidated earnings forecasts

In the medium-term management plan ending with the current fiscal year, the Group has aimed to build a solid earnings base and achieve sustainable growth as an automobility corporate group. During the cumulative period through the third quarter of the consolidated fiscal year under review, the core Finance Business and Automobile Warranty Business have performed steadily, and the Group expects to maintain the initial forecast for operating revenue.

On the other hand, regarding profits, events not anticipated at the beginning of the fiscal year have occurred, such as the recording of one-time expenses and impacts on sales activities due to system failures. The difference in profit before tax between the earnings forecast in the "Consolidated Financial Results for the Fiscal Year Ended March 31, 2025 [IFRS]" announced on May 15, 2025, and the current revised forecast is mainly due to an excess of response costs associated with system failures (300 million yen) and other temporary factors related to the failures that could not be anticipated at the beginning of the fiscal year (200 million yen).

As a result of carefully examining the impact of these factors, the Group have determined that profit before tax and profit attributable to owners of parent may fall below the previously announced forecast. At this time, because it is difficult to reasonably calculate the recovery pace from recovery measures for system failures and other uncertain factors, the Group have revised the full-year consolidated earnings forecast to a range format as follows. (Revised full-year consolidated earnings forecast: operating revenue of 42,000 million yen, profit before tax of 8,500 million yen to 8,700 million yen, profit of 5,800 million yen to 5,900 million yen, profit attributable to owners of parent of 5,800 million yen to 5,900 million yen, and basic earnings per share of 150.70 yen to 153.30 yen)

The consolidated earnings forecast is based on information currently available to the Group, and actual results may differ from the forecast figures due to various factors in the future.

In addition, the Group positions the return of profits to shareholders as one of its most important management issues. While taking the current revision of the earnings forecast seriously, based on confidence in future growth and the improvement of capital efficiency, the Group has decided to acquire treasury shares up to a limit of 1 billion yen, as stated in the "Notice Concerning Decision on Matters Related to Acquisition of Treasury Shares" announced today. As a result, the total return ratio for the current fiscal year is expected to exceed 50%. As for future policy, the Group will implement flexible and continuous shareholder returns, such as dividends and the acquisition of treasury shares, while maintaining a solid financial base and a stable equity ratio.

(Segment information)

(1) General information on reporting segments

The Group's reporting segments consist of the Group's constituent units for which separate financial information is available, and are subject to periodic review by the Board of Directors to determine the allocation of management resources and to evaluate business performance.

The Group reports in three segments: the Finance business, Automobile Warranty Business, and Auto Mobility Services Business.

A summary of each reporting segment is provided below.

The Finance Business consists mainly of the Credit Finance Business, which provides financing services that allow customers to pay for products and services in installments, and debt collection services.

The Automobile Warranty Business consists of automobile warranty services that enable customers who choose to add automobile warranty plans when they purchase vehicles through Group partners to obtain repairs free of charge, within the scope specified in advance, for mechanical problems affecting their purchased vehicles, in exchange for payment of a fixed warranty fee.

The Automobility Services Business is made up chiefly of automobility services, which are multiple services useful in operating the automobile distribution business (e.g., the membership-based network business, auto leasing business, vehicle wholesaling, and automotive parts and software sales).

The Group does not allocate assets and liabilities to the business segments employed by the Board of Directors.

(2) Profit or loss by reporting segment

Each segment profit and loss of the Group is generally prepared in the same manner as for the consolidated financial statements. Adjustments and company-wide figures are elimination entries for internal transactions between segments. The prices of internal transactions between segments are based on actual market prices.
