We are pleased to announce that our company has been awarded a letter of appreciation by the Director of the Kishiwada Tax Office in recognition of our ongoing efforts to support the smooth operation of tax administration, as outlined below.

At the Annual General Meeting of the Kishiwada Taxpayers' Association held on Tuesday, May 27, 2025, at the Kishiwada Grand Hall (Kishiwada City, Osaka Prefecture), our company was presented with a letter of appreciation by the Director of the Kishiwada Tax Office. We have consistently and proactively cooperated with the administration of tax affairs. The details of our contributions are as follows.

- Since the introduction of the e-Tax system, we have promoted its adoption by providing guidance on final tax returns to all group companies during each filing season. Additionally, we have set up dedicated computers within the company to create an environment where employees can file their final tax returns using the e-Tax system during working hours.
- Upon the introduction of the Consumption Tax Invoice System, we supported a smooth transition by
 organizing a briefing session for approximately 200 of our business partners. This session was
 conducted with the cooperation of representatives from the Kishiwada Tax Office.
- 3. During the final tax return filing period, we have also provided operational support in the following ways.
 - (1) For customers who have purchased homes from our company, we provide information—confirmed in advance with the Kishiwada Tax Office—on the mortgage loan tax deduction system, as well as guidance on how to make appointments when visiting the tax office.
 - (2) We offer one of our office rooms, located adjacent to the tax office, as a break room for temporary part-time staff hired by the tax office during the final tax return period.
 - (3) We cooperate in securing personnel by distributing the tax office's recruitment flyers for temporary staff to 13 condominium buildings we have supplied within Kishiwada City.

We believe that the commendation recognizes our commitment to fostering sound tax awareness and our ongoing, wide-ranging cooperation with tax administration efforts. It is a great honor to have received this letter of appreciation, and as a member of the local community, we will continue to actively support tax administration going forward.





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
