<u>Vision to Support the Success of the First-Ever Japan-Hosted</u> <u>"2025 U.S.-Japan Sister Cities Summit"</u>

- Strengthening U.S.-Japan Exchange with "GLOBAL WiFi®" -

Vision Inc. (Headquarters: Shinjuku-ku, Tokyo; President, Representative Director and COO: Kenji Ota; hereinafter "Vision") announced that it will provide communication services in support of the "2025 U.S.—Japan Sister Cities Summit" (co-hosted by Izumisano City, presenting sponsor: U.S.—Japan Foundation, supported by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Japan; hereinafter "the Summit"), which will be held from September 16–19, 2025, at the Stargate Hotel Kansai Airport (RICC Hall) in Osaka. This will mark the first time that Sister Cities International (SCI), founded in 1956 and headquartered in Washington, D.C., will host an international summit in Japan.

The Summit coincides with the 170th anniversary of U.S.–Japan diplomatic relations, bringing together diplomats, representatives from 135 municipalities, leaders from 460 sister city partnerships, community organizations, and youth leaders. The event will reflect on the history of U.S.–Japan diplomacy and aim to further strengthen grassroots exchange, economic cooperation, and leadership development.

Vision shares the Summit's theme of "Celebrating Our Legacies, Empowering Our Future" and will support the smooth operation of the Summit and the facilitation of international exchange by providing its "GLOBAL WiFi®" and related communication services.

Support Overview

1. "GLOBAL WiFi®": Official Portable Wi-Fi for Participants from the United States

Participants traveling from the United States will be able to enjoy reliable internet connectivity throughout Japan. VISION USA CORP., VISION's U.S. subsidiary, will provide the official "GLOBAL WiFi® Rental Service" under special conditions.

2. Communication Support for the Summit Secretariat

To ensure seamless international communication, Vision will provide "GLOBAL WiFi®" devices and other mobile communication tools to the Summit Secretariat staff supporting operations on site.



Sister Cities International (SCI), chaired by Carlo Capua, is the world's oldest and largest volunteer network dedicated to citizen diplomacy. Founded in 1956 by U.S. President Dwight D. Eisenhower, SCI promotes international partnerships between U.S. cities, counties, and states with communities around the world.

From September 16 to 19, 2025, SCI will host the first-ever "U.S.—Japan Sister Cities Summit" in Japan at the Stargate Hotel Kansai Airport (RICC Hall) in Izumisano City, Osaka Prefecture. This historic Summit will convene representatives from 135 municipalities, sister city organizations, diplomats, civic leaders, and youth leaders from both the United States and Japan. Coinciding with the 170th anniversary of U.S.—Japan diplomatic relations, the Summit will foster broad-based discussions on topics such as "revitalizing the U.S.—Japan sister city exchanges," "advancing economic cooperation," and "cultivating the next generation of leaders." This will be the first time a sister city summit is held between Japan and the United States. While SCI maintains a network spanning 120 countries and hosts summits in cities across the globe, there are currently no plans for another Japan-hosted summit in the near future. This makes the 2025 Osaka gathering a truly unique opportunity for international exchange.
