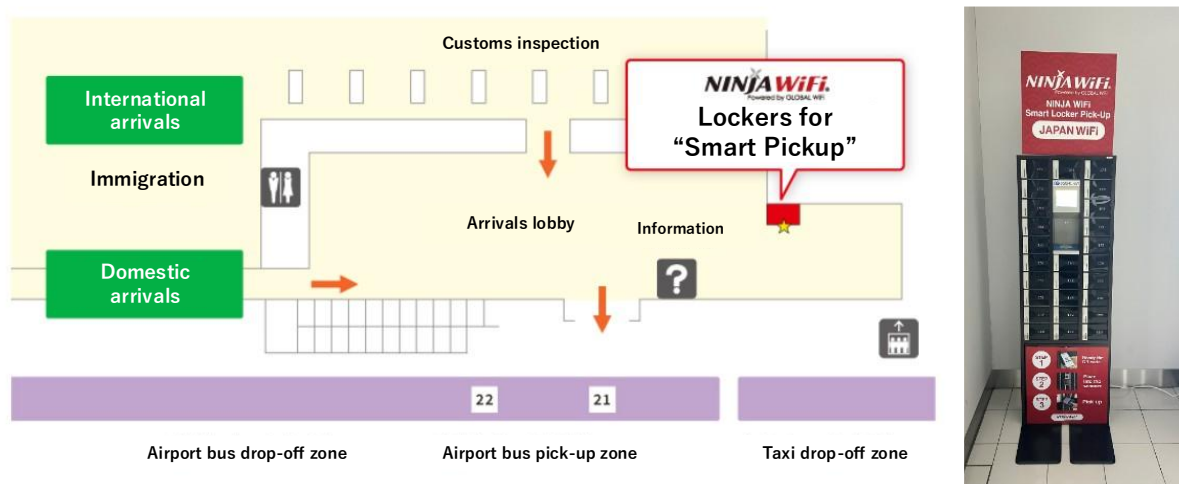

Vision Inc. installs a new “Smart Pickup” Locker for “NINJA WiFi®” on the arrival lobby of Terminal 2 at Chubu Centrair International Airport.

Vision Inc. (Headquarters: Shinjuku-ku, Tokyo; President, Representative Director and COO: Kenji Ota), which operates GLOBAL WiFi Business, Information and Communications Service Business, and Glamping and Tourism Business under the themes of “Connecting People, Connecting the World,” has installed a new “Smart Pickup” Locker on the arrival lobby of Chubu Centrair International Airport Terminal 2, allowing foreign visitors to Japan to pick up their “NINJA WiFi®” rental devices without waiting in line at the counter.

The annual number of foreign visitors to Japan in 2025 reached 42,683,600, a 15.8% increase year-on-year. This surpassed the previous record of 36,870,148 in 2024 by more than 5.8 million, marking a new record (*1). Due to the strong inbound demand in recent years, an increasing number of travelers are choosing “NINJA WiFi®.”

Since the launch of its service, “NINJA WiFi®” has installed touchpoints at various locations across Japan, mainly at airports, where customers can pick up rental devices. Among them, at airports, we focus on installing the lockers at arrival lobbies and transit points in order to improve the environment to pick up rental devices anytime, covering the travel route for visitors to Japan. We will continue to expand the number of installation locations.

Simultaneously, the service supports the provision of up to five “SIM cards” via “Smart Pickup” in response to the needs of visitors to Japan. Through the locker pickup service, we aim to differentiate ourselves from our

competitors and provide a more convenient and comfortable experience for foreign tourists visiting Japan, thereby increasing their satisfaction and expanding our business.

Steps from reservation to pickup



When placing your reservation, select "Smart Pickup" and select your preferred section (time slot). After your order is confirmed, a 2D code will be emailed to you the day before your pickup.

At the airport Smart Locker, open the email containing your 2D code. Please arrive during your designated time slot.

Insert the 2D code face-up into the reader/scanner located at the center of the locker.

Once your reserved locker lights up, retrieve your WiFi device from inside.
