“GLOBAL WiFi®” launches 5 new multi-country plans, covering travel areas such as Europe & North America, China/Hong Kong/Macao, Southeast Asia, and the Middle East.

Vision Inc. (Headquarters: Shinjuku-ku, Tokyo; President, Representative Director and COO: Kenji Ota), which operates GLOBAL WiFi Business, Information and Communications Service Business, and Glamping and Tourism Business under the themes of “Connecting People, Connecting the World,” has launched new multi-country plans for its Wi-Fi router rental service “GLOBAL WiFi®,” designed for customers traveling across multiple countries and regions. The new plans cover the areas of; “Europe & North America,” “Europe & Middle East,” “Southeast Asia,” “China/Hong Kong/Macao,” and the “Middle East.”

In addition to our original plans, we have added five new plans; “Europe & North America,” covering 46 European countries and regions (such as the UK, France, Germany) plus 5 North American destinations (including the US and Canada); “Europe & Middle East,” covering 46 European destinations alongside 8 Middle Eastern countries (such as the UAE and Israel); “Southeast Asia,” covering 8 Southeast Asian countries (including Thailand, Singapore, and Vietnam); “China/Hong Kong/Macao,” covering 8 Middle Eastern countries (including Qatar, Oman, and Saudi Arabia).

These five new plans were introduced based on our analysis of user data to improve usability, assembling coverage based on regional demand. By combining heavily requested countries into single plans, we have enhanced our offerings. We have simplified the application process and made our service more convenient to use.

The new plans eliminate the need to switch services within the covered travel regions, allowing customers to

use the service with peace of mind across multiple countries.

We intend to continually enhance our services according to customer usability and needs.

• About Vision's "communication quality" standards and "signal audits"

Under "GLOBAL WiFi®," Vision provides global high-speed mobile communications based on information updates and verifications conducted in collaboration with partner communications carriers around the world. When adding coverage areas, communication methods, and plans, we always conduct meticulous on-site "signal audits."

After verifying the extent of the coverage area (signal area), including dead spots and locations where signals are blocked by buildings, etc., we measure actual communication speeds. Only if these measurements meet our own communication quality standards do we begin purchasing communications bandwidth.

The verification is undertaken by our own overseas staff and partner companies in some areas.

There are many 5G communications carriers around the world, but at Vision, we only begin providing service in areas that meet our quality standards.
